

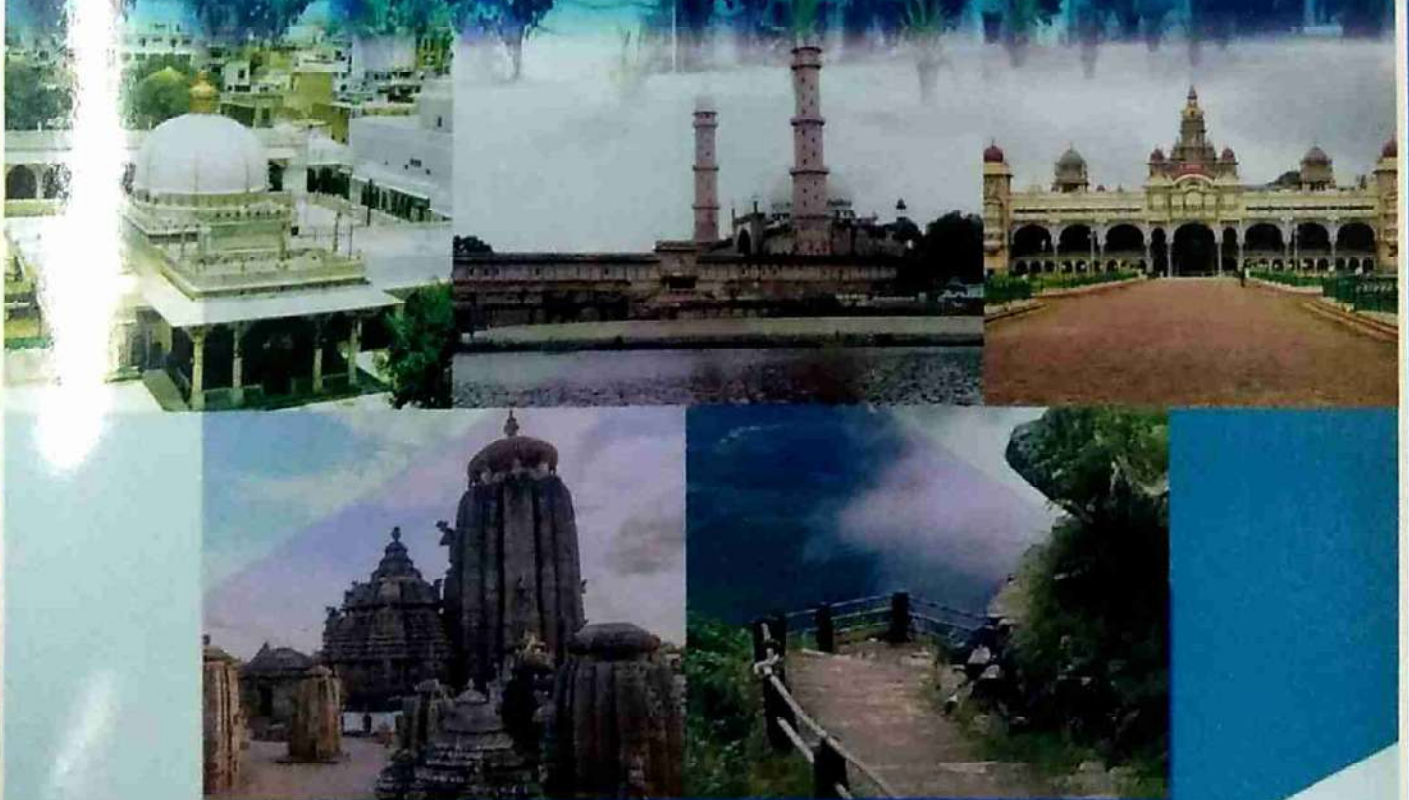

REGIONAL INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION, AJMER AT A GLANCE

In 1961, the Government of India established the National Council of Educational Research & Training as an autonomous organization to assist and advise the Government at center and in States in the implementation of their policies for education, especially to bring about qualitative changes in school education and teacher preparation. The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) since its inception, has been contributing for the improvement of school education in the country. The Council, through its constituent units including the Regional Institutes of Education, is supporting States and Union Territories (UTs) for qualitative improvement in education by way of variety of activities like curriculum development including textual material development, capacity building of in-service teachers, preparing prospective teachers and teacher educators, conducting educational surveys, extension activities and research. Regional Institute of Education, Ajmer formerly known as Regional College of Education supports Northern States and UTs namely Jammu & Kashmir, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Chandigarh and Delhi, in meeting their educational needs. The Institute is committed to improve the quality of education and human values. The Institute is affiliated to the Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer and its programmes/courses are recognized by the NCTE, New Delhi. It is controlled and managed by NCERT.

Mission

- Innovating and evolving ways and means befitting the emerging scenario in school education to uphold the value & enshrined in the Indian Constitution.
- Ensuring the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of educational programmes and policies of Government of India and NCERT.
- Catering to the educational needs of the Northern Region (Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Delhi and Chandigarh).
- Facilitating and undertaking research, development and training for the holistic development of school education and teacher education.

Programmes

Pre-Service Programmes

Institute is offering Pre-Service Programmes namely four year integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. & B.A.B.Ed., Two Year B.Ed. & M.Ed. programmes and Diploma Course in Guidance and Counselling. Students in these programmes are admitted from the Northern Region (Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Delhi, Rajasthan and Chandigarh).

Research

The Institute conducts research in the area of Curriculum Development, Teacher Education, Science Education, Environmental Education, Language and Social

Science Education and other regional priorities. Research projects can be categorized (I) as guided by the faculty leading to the Ph.D. Degree in their area of interest, (II) the research undertaken and carried out by the faculty themselves as minor projects in the field of School Education. Faculty members of all the four Departments (DESM, DE, DESSH & DEE) are actively engaged in different kinds of researches.

Departments

To facilitate the execution of various activities, following five departments have been constituted in the Institute:

1. Department of Education (DE)

Besides the core component of Education, the Department manages the Educational Technology, Education of Groups with special needs, Physical Education, Population Education and Computer Education. The Department also has a well-equipped Psychology Laboratory and well-developed State of Art Studio along with E-learning centre.

2. Department of Extension Education (DEE):

The Department has the responsibility of looking after different extension programmes pertaining to research, development of instructional material and training. It also has the dissemination and clearing house function.

3. Department of Education in Social Science and Humanities (DESSH)

The Department comprises of English, Hindi, Urdu and Social Sciences Sections. There is a Geography Laboratory in the department too.

4. Department of Education in Science and Mathematics (DESM)

The Department consists of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Technology and Agriculture Sections and the Teaching Learning Aids Centre. All the sections have well equipped laboratories to enable students to conduct experiments and develop teaching aids. The technology section with its Electrical Lab and Wood work shop is functioning as a service department besides engaging the work experience classes. An Environmental Education Theme Park is also functional in the campus.

Demonstration Multipurpose School

The DM School was established in 1964 as a pace setting institution. It also serves as RIE's laboratory for conducting educational experiments and trying out innovations in the teaching learning process. It is a co-educational school and follows the three language formula. It is affiliated to the CBSE and provides education to students from pre-primary to Senior Secondary. At the Senior Secondary level students have the options of Humanities, Science, Commerce and Vocational streams. The School has primary and pre-primary section. The school has its separate library, well equipped laboratories, computer room and other necessary physical facilities. The School library has collection of about 30,000 books, Newspapers (Hindi & English), above 100 Multimedia CD/DVDs. The library has an annual subscription of 37 magazines.

Research and Development

The Institute conducts research in the areas of curriculum development, curriculum analysis, teacher education, science education, environmental education, early child care education and other areas of regional and national importance. A biannual journal "Educational Trends" is also promoted and published under the co-ordination of IQAC cell of the Institute.

- **Extension Service**

Besides preparing teachers through pre-service courses, the institute performs a variety of extension services to make teaching and learning effective in schools. Some of them include

- Orientation/training programmes for strengthening the faculties of SCERTs, DIETs, CTES and IASEs on methods, content, instructional aids, school management, curriculum development, textbook writing, developing e-content etc.
- Working as a monitoring and coordinating agency for the effective implementation of National Schemes related to School Education such as SSA, RMSA, RAA, Environmental Education, Population Education, Vocationalization of education, etc.
- Undertaking research projects in areas like innovating practices, peace education, environmental education, field testing of NCERT textbooks and offering feedback and providing consultancy of boards of education. Also conducting achievement survey.
- Holding meetings with the state level educational authorities with a view to finding out obstacles in the way of improving the quality of School Education and helping them to find out the remedies.
- Organizing National Seminar / Conference / Workshop / Consultation / Regional Meet /Nurturance programmes for NTS awardees, orientation programmes on learning outcomes.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

IQAC has been constituted as per the guidelines of the NAAC and its details are available on institute's website (<http://www.rieajmer.raj.nic.in>).IQAC has also been making efforts for keeping the records/files of NAAC, Peer Team Reports, AQAR, and Certificate of Accreditation Outcomes and regularly uploads/ reports on its activities, as well as for hosting the AQAR.IQAC has always been consistent in its efforts for sustaining and promoting academic excellence in the institution. It has taken measures to ensure conducive learner centric environment. For the last two years, IQAC has been successful in creating awareness regarding various aspects of quality issues, coordinating different activities in association with Departments and Faculty members for upgrading the academic standards of the Institute. NAAC Peer Team visited the Institute and awarded A+ Grade to the Institute.

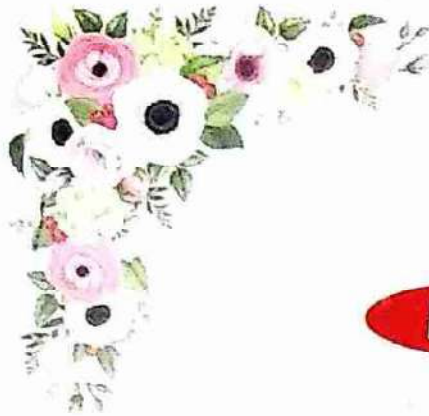




MESSAGE

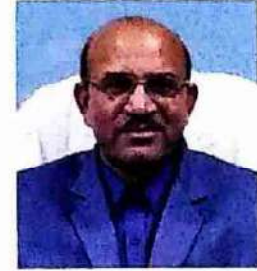
